The Department of Business and Technology offers six Associate of Science (A.S.) and Associate of Arts (A.A.) major degree programs known as **Tennessee Transfer Pathways** (TTPs) that, if completed, guarantee that the student may transfer to any Tennessee public university (University of Tennessee and Tennessee Board of Regents universities) and several private universities as a junior.

These TTPs include:

- ▶ Accounting
- ▶ Business Administration
- ▶ Computer Science
- ▶ Economics
- ▶ Information Systems
- ▶ Pre-Engineering (Civil, Electrical or Mechanical)

In addition to these TTPs, the Department of Business and Technology also offers non-TTP University Parallel Majors in Business Education and Entrepreneurship.

For students desiring a two-year, non-transfer degree program designed to prepare them to enter the workforce, the Department of Business and Technology offers four Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree programs. These career path programs include:

- ▶ Accounting
- ▶ Business Computer Applications
- ▶ Business Computer Programming
- ▶ Management
