

MSCC Honors Program Student Advisory Board

Criteria:

- Must be an active member of the Honors Program and meet all eligibility requirements AND
 - Must be nominated by an Honors Faculty member and approved by the Honors Program Committee
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Structure:

- Members will be selected to represent each campus. There will be a minimum of two members from each campus, a freshman and a sophomore. Additional members may be chosen at the discretion of the selection committee.
 - Freshman who are nominated and selected to serve on the council will be expected to serve as sophomores.
 - For the first year and under other special circumstances (such as a member vacancy), sophomores will be nominated and expected to serve until graduation.
 - One member of the council will come from the Honors Program Alumni Association and will be appointed by the director. This member may come from the alumni body at large or the alumni board, as long as he or she is not the chair or vice-chair. The Alumni member will serve a one-year term and may be reappointed in subsequent years.
 - Once the council is selected, they may vote to appoint members of the council to serve as vice-chair, secretary, or any other position that they deem necessary. The chair of the board will be selected by the director.
 - The chair and vice-chair will be the primary points of contact for the director.
 - The council should meet a minimum of twice a semester. These meetings may be scheduled at the discretion of the council or the director. As the council sees fit, more meetings may be scheduled at any point during the semester.
 - Meetings should be held at one of the Motlow campuses or some other mutually agreed upon location.
 - Changes to the Honors Student Council bylaws may be voted upon by the council. Motions receiving at least a 2/3 majority may be sent to the director for final approval.
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Tasks/Purposes:

- The primary purpose of the Honors Student Council is to provide a voice for Honors students as a whole.
- The council will act as a direct line from the Honors student body to the Honors director and make suggestions regarding important matters, such as Honors events and curriculum.
