Criteria for Global Ambassador Scholarship Applicants

- Must have completed 12 credit hours at Motlow College by the start of the program
- Must be enrolled full-time at Motlow during Spring Semester, 2012
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (***First Semester Freshmen*** – if your GPA is not a 3.0 after Fall semester, any Ambassadorship award will be rescinded)
- Must have completed online TnCIS application (www.tncis.org)

Global Ambassador Scholarship Application materials

Please submit the following as part of your application:

- Motlow College Study Abroad Application Form
- Official Transcript
- Two letters of recommendation (one academic, one personal)
- A 250 word essay explaining how you will be a representative of the school and promote goodwill between students, schools, and countries
- A 250 word proposal detailing at least two ways in which you will assist in recruiting new applicants for the study abroad program
