


# To download a the **FREE Adobe Acrobat Reader**

Go to <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>

When downloading Adobe Reader (any version), please make sure you **UNCHECK THE BOX**. This example asks to install “Google Chrome – optional”. See green arrows below.

**NOTE:** This recommendation shown below is for “Google Chrome”, it has been seen where it asks to install various programs, not just Chrome so please be careful. It is set to automatically install if box is left checked.
