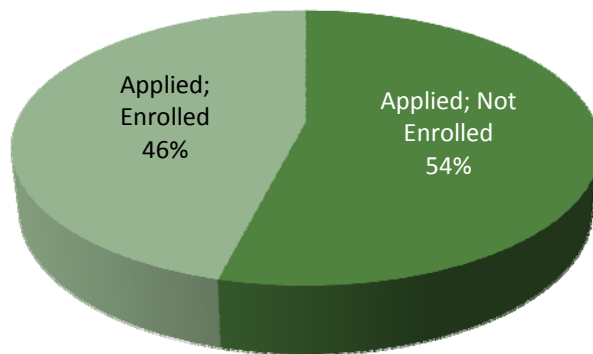

Age 60 or Totally Disabled - Resident of Tennessee may audit without payment of maintenance fees.

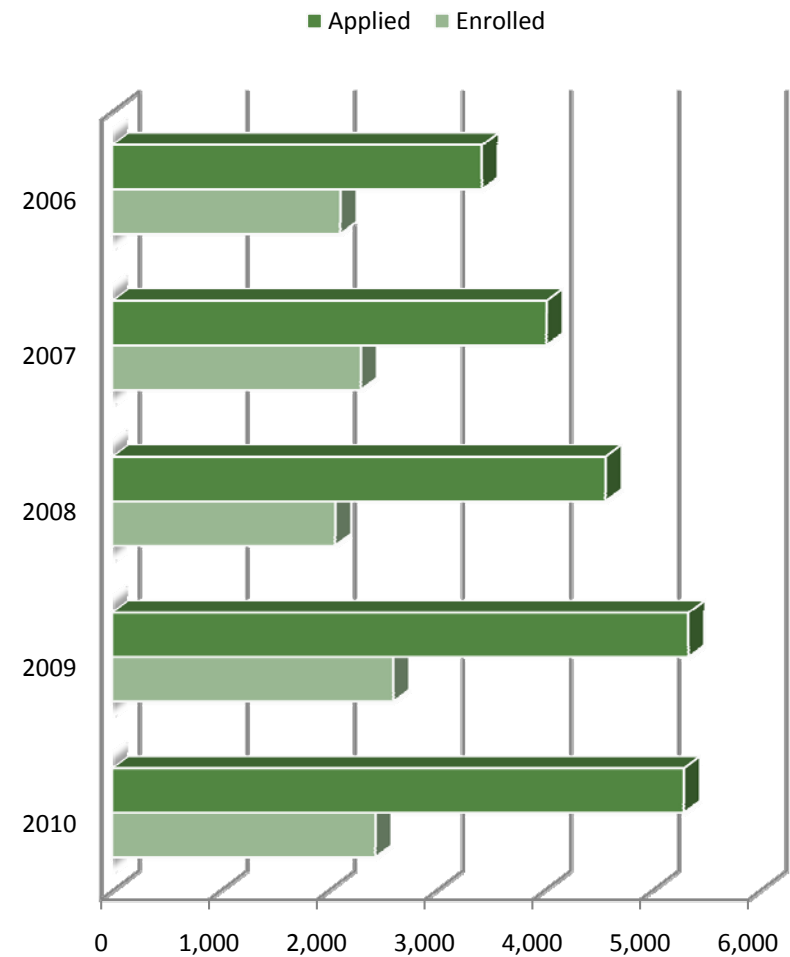

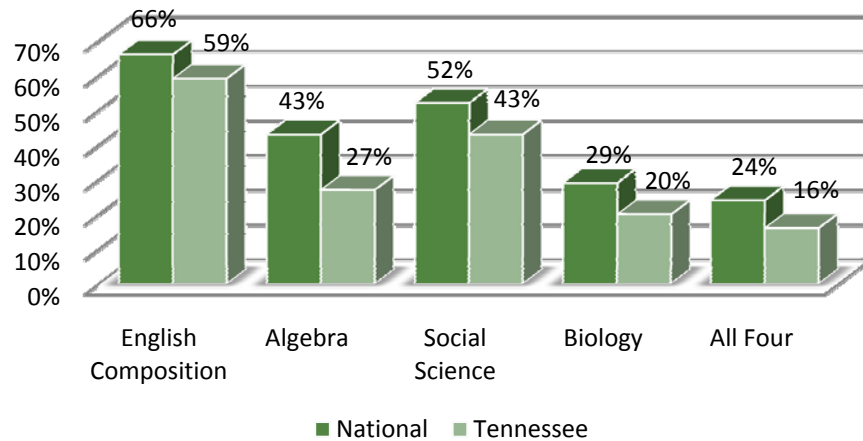

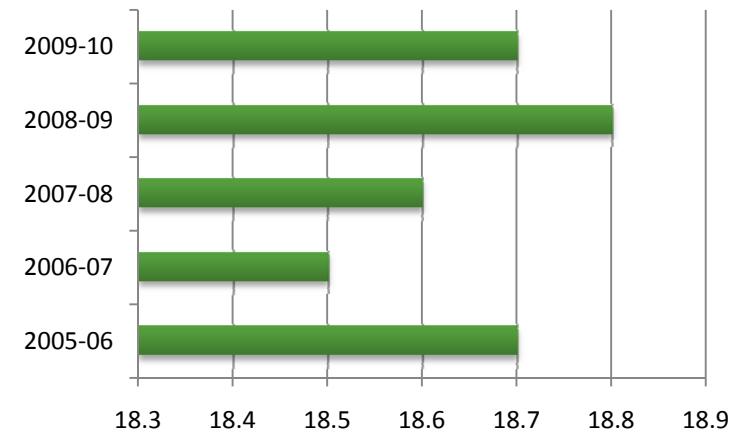
