

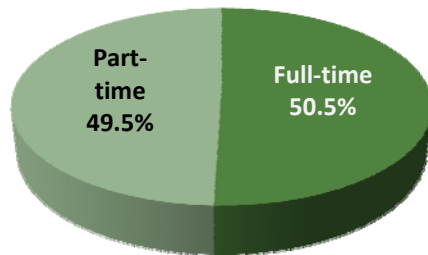

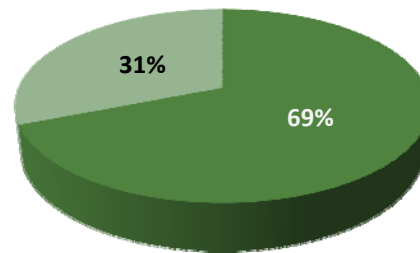

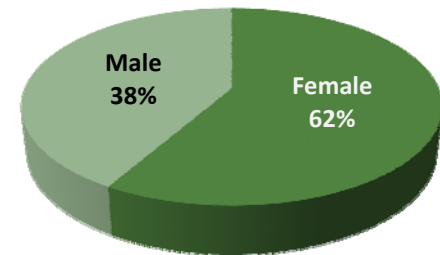

Fall 2010**

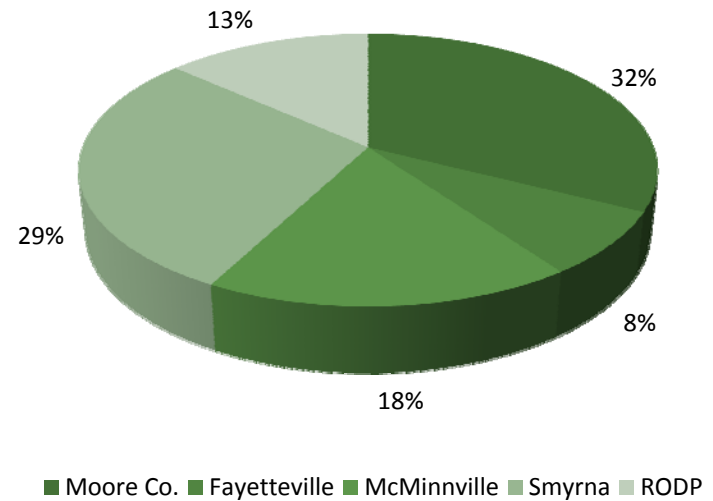

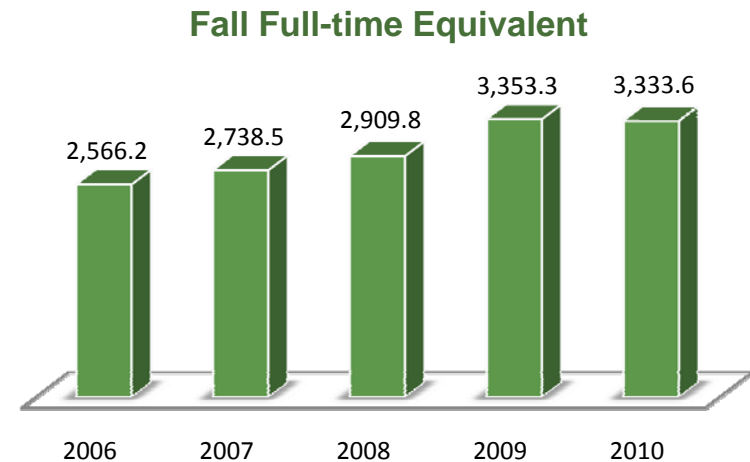

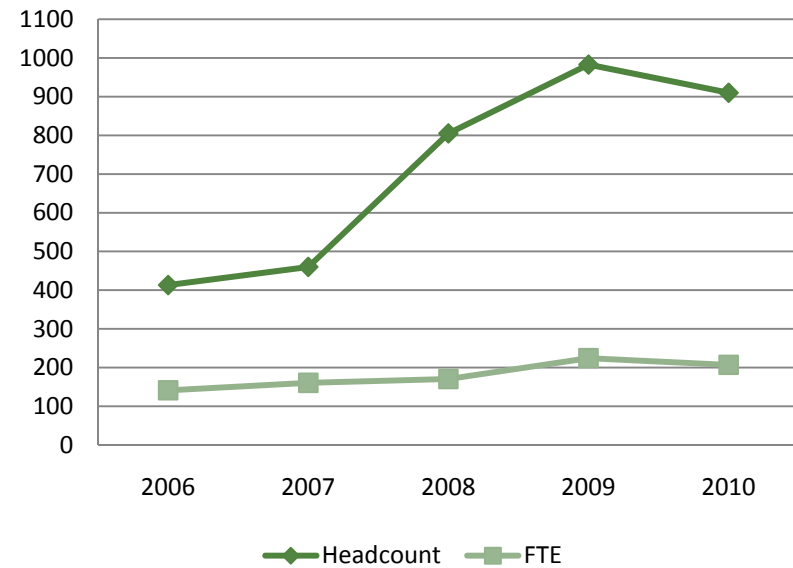

RODP Enrollment

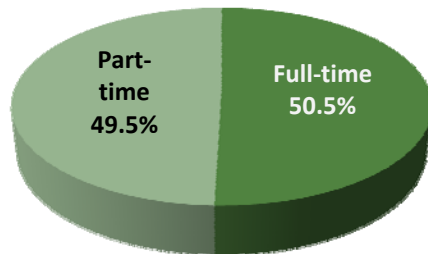

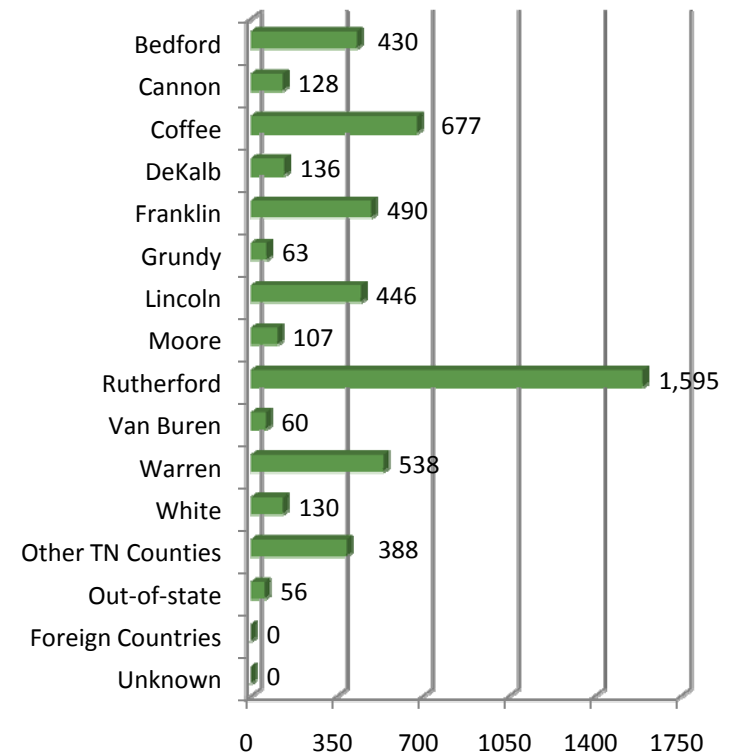
