

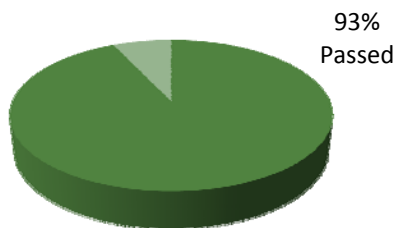

Developmental Studies Success Rates

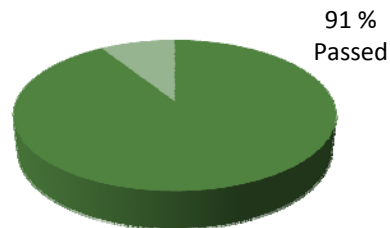
Approximately 73% of Motlow's first-time freshmen are recommended for enrollment in Developmental Studies courses. In spring 2010, Developmental Studies Program (DSP) completers had a higher pass rate in college-level courses than non-DSP completers for each subject area.

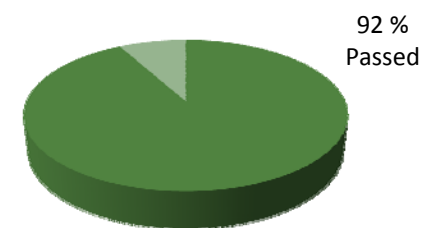
DSPM Student Success Rate in College-Level Course

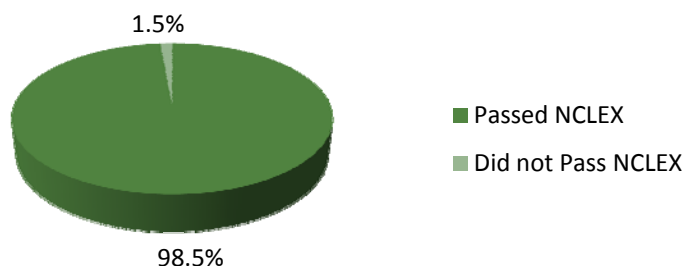

NCLEX Scores

The National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) for Registered Nurses is a computer-adaptive test (CAT) of entry-level nursing competence. Passing the exam is required of candidates for licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN) by all US state and territorial Boards of Nursing. The NCLEX examination is designed to test the knowledge, skills and abilities essential to the safe and effective practice of nursing at the entry-level.
