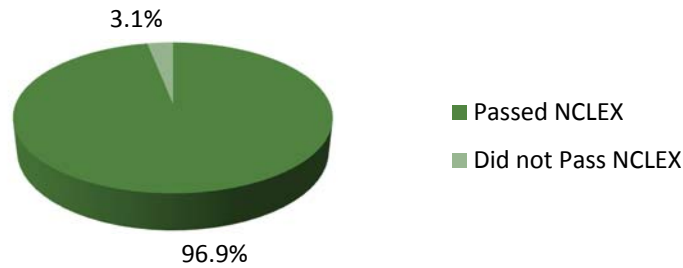


NCLEX Scores

The National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) for Registered Nurses is a computer-adaptive test (CAT) of entry-level nursing competence. Passing the exam is required of candidates for licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN) by all US state and territorial Boards of Nursing. The NCLEX examination is designed to test the knowledge, skills and abilities essential to the safe and effective practice of nursing at the entry-level.
